



BHAA POLICY ON MOVING PLAYERS UP

1. A player must have played a minimum of 2 years in the age group that corresponds to their age. (If a player starts tee ball at age 3 then they can not move up until they are 6)
2. A player must be the oldest age of their age group. (example 8 years old and wants to move up to Junior or 10U)
3. A player has exhibited the necessary skills to warrant playing up. (example: all star team or being called up to play in older age group)
4. Parent must sign waiver releasing BHAA from liability if injury occurs.
5. No player who is in their first year with BHAA will be afforded the opportunity to move up in age divisions.
